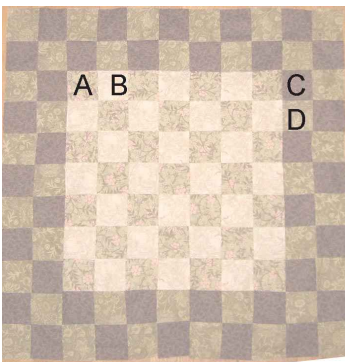
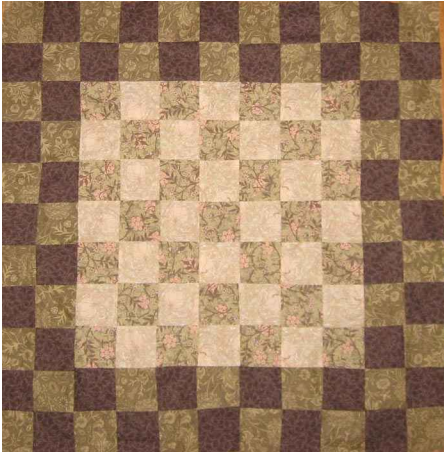


GAME BOARD

• Size: 27 1/2" Square



Cutting:

Method 1. Cut & piece squares.

All pieces are cut to 3" squares.

A Medium # 1. Cut 25.

B Light. Cut 24.

C Dark. Cut 32.

D Medium #2. Cut 30.

Method 2. Cut & piece strips.

All strips are cut 3" wide by the width of the fabric.

A Medium # 1. Cut 2 strips.

B Light. Cut 2 strips.

C Dark. Cut 3 strips.

D Medium #2. Cut 3 strips.



Sewing:

Method 1. Cut & piece as squares.

1. For the center area, begin by stitching a medium #1 to a light square, creating a rectangular domino that is medium and light. Press towards the medium.

2. Repeat this so you have 24 medium / light dominoes.

3. You should have one left over medium square.

4. Stitch a strip of seven dominoes to make a checkerboard effect.



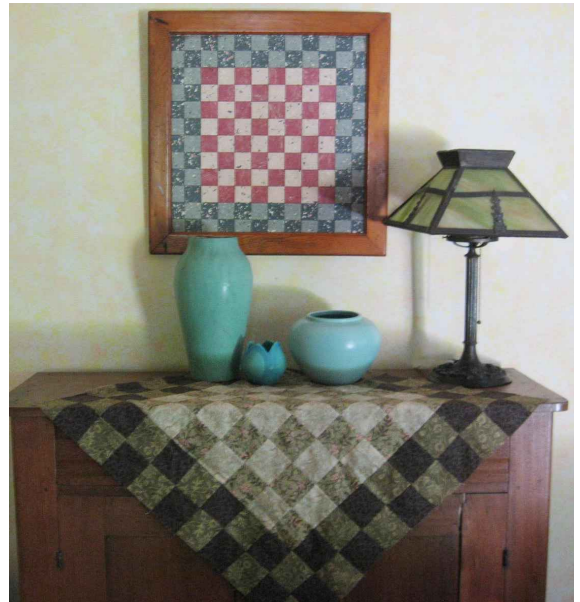
5. Repeat this twice so you have 3 strips of 7 dominoes each.

6. Stitch these three strips together.

7. For the last strip turn 3 dominoes on their sides. Sew a strip of 3 end to end. Add your one extra square on the end.



8. Add this last strip. You want to be sure the mediums are in the corners.



Here's a small table-topper with a design adapted from an old checkerboard made out of linoleum. It's a simple pattern for four 1/4 yard cuts.

9. For the border, stitch rectangular dominoes of medium #2 and dark squares.

10. Repeat this so you have 36 dark/medium dominoes. Press towards the dark.

11. Stitch a strip of seven dominoes to make a checkerboard effect for the side borders. Repeat so you have two side borders. Add these to the center.

12. Stitch a strip of eleven dominoes to make a checkerboard effect. Repeat so you have the top and bottom borders. Add these.

Method # 2. Cut and piece as strips.

1. Stitch a strip of medium# 1 to a strip of light. Press towards the medium. Repeat.

2. Stitch a strip of medium #2 to a strip of dark. Press towards the dark. Repeat this twice so you have 3 medium/dark strip units.

3. Cut across the strips every 3" to make rectangles: the 2 color dominoes.

4. Follow directions above from #4 to 12 using these 2 color dominoes. Note: you'll have left over dominoes. Rip the seam out of one leftover to get the extra medium #1 square for step 7.
